1 in 10 UK workers say that they have witnessed possible corruption, wrongdoing or malpractice

So, why don't more workers report?

42% believe that no action will be taken ^[5]

44% fear retaliation ^[6]

45% believe organisation is not ethically committed ^[7]

55% don't want to get involved ^[8]

57% believe it won't make a difference ^[9]

57% believe there's no legal protection for whistleblowers ^[10]

Yet 92% of leaders are likely to act

It's a question of

trust

in the organisations' whistleblowing system

Only **57%** of British workers know their employer has a whistleblowing policy ^[11]

Only **39%** of organisations promote whistleblowing education to their workforce ^[12]

Only **17%** of organisations use an independent, impartial whistleblowing reporting channel ^[13]
